At *ALANNIA RESORTS* we are committed to environmental protection and business management focused on minimizing and reducing environmental impact. The management of *ALANNIA RESORTS* had a dream, a dream come true:

SUSTAINABLE ALANNIA, the planet deserves these holidays.

Our commitment to the planet:

- Maintain Travelife certification in all resorts.
- Obtain the Miteco "Carbon Footprint Calculation" seal at all resorts.
- Obtain the Miteco "Reduce Carbon Footprint" seal in 25% of resorts.
- Provide a bicycle rental service at all resorts.
- Provide electric vehicle charging points in all resorts.
- At least, 40% of our energy will be green.
- Reduce energy consumption (kWh/PAX) by 3% compared to the previous year.
- Reduce water consumption (l/PAX) by 3% compared to the previous year.
- Reduce the carbon footprint in scope 1+2 (kg CO₂/PAX) by 5% compared to the previous year.
- Calculate the carbon footprint in scope 1+2+3 at all resorts.
- Reduce the purchase of single-use plastics (ud/PAX) by 10% compared to the previous year.
- Include vegan, vegetarian, gluten-free and/ or proximity dishes in restaurant menus.

Our commitment to people:

- Reduce the accident rate by 1% compared to the previous year.
- Increase of 3% in the responses to customer reviews, compared to the previous year.
- Increase the average score of sustainability initiatives in the customer survey by 3% compared to the previous year.
- Implement 3 accessibility improvements in each resort.
- Perform a cleanup event of close areas by resort.
- Increase by 5% the kg of products donated to the Red Cross from supermarkets, compared to the previous year.
- Have clothing collection points for recycling or donation in all resorts.
- Get involved in the project of collaboration with Seur "Plugs for a new life", in all resorts.
